(their response) What is your beloved more than another beloved O fairest among women? (5:8,9)

She goes on to describe him and appreciate him in great detail...his head, hair, eyes, cheeks, lips, hands, body, legs and countenance

His mouth is most sweet, yes, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem! (5:16)
